9-Panel Drug

Adulteration component *Immediate results

6-Panel Oral Drug

Results within 10 minutes

Ethylglucuronide (EtG) (alcohol)

Highly sensitive test. Client needs to be made aware of substances to avoid during testing period. Longer time spectrum of detection (2—5 days previous). Only for clients court ordered to abstain.

6-Panel Expanded Opiate Panel

Detects lower levels of Oxycodone, Vicodin, Percocet, and others.
Other tests for opiates are positive only at a much higher detection level.

5-Panel Hair Shaft

* Results 3-4 days Goes back approximately 3 months.

40-Panel Steroid

2 masking agents *Results 3-4 days High levels of steroids have been linked to violent behavior.

* Immediate results
