

How to purchase NALOXONE

Naloxone (Narcan) is the antidote to an opioid overdose.

In Texas, anyone can purchase, possess and administer naloxone.

Two ways to purchase:

1.

Your doctor can prescribe it, and you can purchase it at your pharmacy of choice.

2.

A standing order is available at Walgreens and CVS pharmacies.

This means that you do not need a prescription from your doctor.

You can use insurance when purchasing naloxone.

An out-of-pocket expense may apply.

You can pay the full price if you do not have insurance or you can use a prescription discount program or app such as GoodRx.

If you are told that you are unable to purchase Narcan over the counter at Walgreens or CVS, gently remind them that they have standing orders from Dr. Kowalchuck and Dr. Tirado, respectively, and to look it up in their system.

Most pharmacies carry the Narcan auto-injector nasal spray.

It is easy to use.

If the pharmacy can not dispense it right away, you can place an order and receive it within 24 hours.
